#### St. Patrick

St. **Patrick** was born in **England**. He was born with the name **Maewyn** (*May-Win*) Succat (*Socket*) and he grew up just as other kids did. He went to school, and he went to church. At the age of 16, he was **kidnapped** by **pirates** and taken to **Ireland**. There He was renamed "Pig Boy." He fed pigs, and watched the people of Ireland pray to things like Twigs and Pond Scum. They practiced a religion called **Paganism**. Pagans believe that everything is a god and that everything is powerful. There are wrong! Then he remembered what he learned in church about God. He started to pray all day every day, and soon, he would pray over 100 times a day! He had already lived there for 6 years! One night as he was praying, he was told by God that he could leave Ireland. He went on a boat to France, and started school again. After living in France for a while, he had a dream that the people of Ireland needed him to teach them about **God**. He finished school, and became a **Bishop**, and changed his name to Patrick. The **Saint** returned to Ireland and taught the people there about the **Trinity** using a 3 leaf **clover**. The Trinity is similar to a clover or Shamrock because he is 3 persons in one. He is God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy **Spirit**. A shamrock has 3 leaves and it is one plant. St. Patrick died on March 17, and became a saint in the 12<sup>th</sup> Century.
