



The Nativity of Christ

The birth of Jesus Christ, Christmas, is one of the twelve great feasts of the Orthodox Church. Jesus was born of the most holy Virgin Mary, Theotokos, who was told by the Angel Gabriel that she would have the Messiah.

A law was passed by a ruler named Caesar, saying that every man had to go back to the land he was born in and pay taxes. Joseph, Mary's betrothed, was born in the City of Bethlehem, so the two had to travel a long way from Galilee to Bethlehem. When they got there, there was no room for them in any house, so they had to spend the night in a stable full of animals. Jesus was born in a manger in that stable.

Three Wiseman from the east had seen a bright star shining in the sky, and they knew this showed that the savior was born. They followed the star to Bethlehem, where they worshipped Jesus and brought him gifts of myrrh, frankincense, and gold.

Shepherds watching their sheep in the fields were visited by a choir of angels singing "Glory to God in the Highest, and on Earth peace, good will to men!" At first they were afraid, but then they went to see the messiah and praise him.

The Church celebrates the Birth of Our Lord on December 25.
